Use MFT money, with option city do the demolition, will lower estimate around \$12,000.00 this lowers the estimate to about \$28,625.00. By only doing sidewalk and not touching ramps it would be around \$30,000.00. The discussion was for the City employees tear out the sidewalk, then have Mauer Stutes guiding them on the handicap ramps, This could be done next summer with Dennis and a couple of summer time helpers.
