

LIQUOR COMMISSION
January 20, 2015

The City of Lewistown Liquor Commission met Tuesday, January 20, 2015 at 6:15 p.m. at City Hall with the following present: Mayor John King, Commissions Reba Ford, John Barclay, Billie Simmons and Hannah Schrod, Canton Daily Ledger, Officer Keith Doubet. Absent commissioner Kevin Delmastro.

Officer Doubet states New Years Eve. First part of incident started at 2:15 p.m. (happened more than once) at The Pub, witnessed Dakota Harn walking down street with beer drinking it, just walked out of The Pub. When approached by Doubet, he got smart mouthed. Adkins also arrived at scene. Beer $\frac{3}{4}$ full sitting on sidewalk so was just purchased after hour hours. Mr. Harn had cut on head and hand, stated he fell, but looked like was in fight. At this time bar was empty. Adkins called Doubet at 3:15 a.m. stated patrons in bar were drinking, arrived at bar at 3:20 to see why patrons were drinking and still in the bar. Went into bar, told bartender, Randy Mendez that no serving of beer at this time. Police officers exited bar at 3:30 a.m.

Doubet did not see Harn walk out of The Pub.

Another time Travis Derry, and others leave bar with something under coat. They stated they did not have anything. Doubet left but turned around and went back to the area, found four drinks just dumped out where Derry and others were at.

Doubet states that people are still smoking in 2 of 4 bars. King states maybe try to enforce the ordinance regarding smoking. Discuss at later time.

Ford wants a ticket written to The Pub for liquor ordinance violation regarding New Years Eve. Mayor states should close them down one weekend, such as Super Bowl Weekend.
