MINUTES:

Alderman Spotloe made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 12, 2016 meeting, Seconded by Alderman Weese, the motion carried with all ayes.

OLD BUSINESS:

- A. Review and Vote on Employee Contract of Certified Operator of Wastewater Treatment Plant for Patrick Colglazier. Alderman Spotloe made a motion to approve the Employee Contract of Certified Operator of Wastewater Treatment Plant and the City of Lewistown with Patrick Colglazier, second by Burget Roll call vote, Alderman Ford yes, Kelley yes, Weese yes, Barclay no because he had not read over it yet, Burget yes and Spotloe yes, motion carried.
- B. Discuss and vote on Food Truck Ordinance. Mayor King explained that you can't amend something that does not pertain to this situation. The Alderman had copy of Peoria ordinance to look at. It was suggested maybe get a signed statement by vendor, also maybe insurance waiver. The old ordinance/regulations regarding vendors of merchandise for example are peddling fresh fish, or fresh fruit per day. There are no regulations at this time for a food vendor. Need an Ordinance regarding regulations for things such as how long at a time a vendor can sit at one spot and where, and how many days a week, also need to establish how many permits allowed for the city. Barclay came prepared with a list of different rules and regulations for ordinance to accommodate Lewistown.

There will be a committee meeting before next scheduled city council meeting at 6:00 p.m. on February 9, 2016, with attorney present to form an Ordinance.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Adopt resolution to close Main Street from Avenue L to Milton for Homecoming Parade September 16, 2016. Alderman Spotloe made a motion to close Main Street from Avenue L to Milton for Homecoming Parade on September 16, 2016, Barclay seconded, roll call vote all ayes, motion carried.
- B. Approve estimate for Inspection of Ground 500,000 storage tank (steel reservoir) for \$2,975.00 and 200,000 Water tower estimate for maintenance inspection services in the amount of \$2,775.00 Alderman Ford wanted to know if fee for maintenance at a later time and other details and they did not have a fee schedule "C" of additional fees attached to the estimate like it said. Table this at this time.
- C. Approve Lawver contract for purchase of property located at 815 East Washington, Lewistown. No contract yet, Alderman Barclay asked Attorney Collins if he needs list of questions regarding property. Maybe have a contractor go in and do examination of property regarding roof, windows, foundation and determine after repairs it will be livable. Table till next meeting.
