- 1. Amend 2011-8 Ordinance relating to water line breaks. With tracer makes it a lot easier to fix water line breaks, the lines must be copper. Motion made by Alderman Burget to amend the 2011-8 Ordinance relating to water line breaks, second by Kelly, roll call vote motion carried with all ayes.
- 2. Discuss sidewalk on Northwest corner of square. An area in sidewalk is sinking, it was discovered that the sewer line is the problem; they may have to dig up street. Would like to keep service ramp to use as handicap ramp by back door of Courthouse if possible.
- 3. Someone complained about the house on Main Street that had fire in July. Animals (squirrels) running in and out of broken windows, they need covered. The house is under investigation for meth lab in the attic.
- 4. Kim Pascal runs a Day Care Center out of her house, the sidewalk is bad. The sidewalk in front of her house is on list already per Mayor King but will probably be next year before done.
