- a. Discuss Casey's North and Casey's South wanting to change their Packaged Liquor License from D-1 License to D License – Mayor King knew that Mrs. Mutton was already told we are not going to give out anymore licenses. Commissioner Simmons states that we already have a liquor store in town. Commissioner Ford agrees that we have liquor store and grocery store that sells hard liquor. All three agree NO on allowing the Casey's North and South to change their Liquor License from D-1 to D, the recommendation is to be sent to the City Council of NO.
- b. Discuss County Market wanting to sell Beer for Consumption on the Premises Commissioner Ford said there is no need to be able to walk all over the store with a beer in your hand. What will prevent someone buying a beer then giving it to someone under age? Commissioner Simmons said there are too many kids in store with no supervision. The recommendation to the City Council is NO on allowing the selling of beer for consumption on the premises of County Market.
