Adam Pulley with CLA said they had worked with the city previously doing the audit, then after that they have been helping the city keep up to date and balance all accounts and have the accounts ready for the auditors. Alderperson Clark asked how much are the charges and how much last year? They charge by the hour. The new contract says \$130.00 an hour. They work with many municipalities/government agencies; Havana and Canton are a couple of them. Cindy Goddard explained that the charges were divided up between administration, water and waste water so they also help Cindy Havens. Around \$20,000.00 were the charges for the past year said Beka from CLA. The fees should be cut in half this next year. City Clerk Cindy Goddard said that the last audit was done in 2-3 hours and previously they were here up to 2 weeks here. Alderperson Miller said he understands that they were brought in originally to get everything back in order. Cindy Goddard explained that eventually Beka will not be coming out and just phone calls can solve any problems. Alderperson Lafary suggested keeping them one more year. Alderperson Miller made a motion to approve the CliftonLarsonAllen engagement letter, second by Alderperson Pascal, roll call vote, motion carried all ayes.
