

Business to Discuss: FY27 Budget

Members present: Alderperson Clark, Levingston, Spotloe, Mayor Goddard and Clerk  
Nelson Absent: Alderperson Long, Ward, Miller

Alderperson Clark called the meeting to order at 10:00. The city's accountant Beka was present to present the budget to the committee. Beka stated that she had also included a paper showing what each employee was making and what they would make with 2%, 4% and \$1 raise. Beka stated that she had went over the budget with department heads prior to the meeting to adjust anything. Alderperson Clark stated that the \$1 raise looked like it would be the best for the employee's. Alderperson Spotloe stated that the \$1 raise was better for employee's making less than \$25 an hour and the 4% was better for the employees making more than \$25 an hour. Beka stated that IMRF had dropped their rates so it was better. Beka stated that MFT was down \$14,000 and TIF was down \$21,000. Alderperson Clark stated the committee would recommend to the council for a \$1 raise for any employee making less than \$25 an hour and a 4% raise for any employee making more than \$25 an hour. Alderperson Clark made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 10:35 a.m.
