The Lewistown City Council met in regular session in the council chambers. Mayor Cindy Goddard called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**CLERKS REPORT/MINUTES:** Natalie Nelson. Absent.

Alderperson Miller made a motion to approve the minutes of April 28th, 2026, Special Council Meeting & Committee Meeting second by Alderperson Clark, the motion carried all ayes.


**PRESENTATION OF BILLS:**
